1. Submission and Peer Review Process

Once the submission materials have been prepared in accordance with the Author Guidelines, manuscripts should be submitted online at wiley.atyponrex.com/journal/CDQ.

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Article and Free Format Submission

In addition to the usual structured submission, *The Career Development Quarterly* also offers [Free Format submission](#) for a simplified and streamlined submission process.

General Submission Information:

- **Manuscripts must be prepared using APA Style (7th ed.): Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (7th ed.; APA, 2020).**
 - If you are unfamiliar with APA Style, please see: <https://apastyle.apa.org/>
 - Formatting must adhere to APA Journal Article Reporting Standards (JARS)
- Typical manuscript length is 25-30 pages, inclusive of main body, references, tables, and figures.
- All submissions are automatically reviewed by Crossref, an online plagiarism similarity check

Before you submit, you will need:

- The title page of the manuscript, including:
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 - Coauthor details: full name, institutional affiliation where the work was conducted, with a footnote for each author's present address if different, and email address. (*Why is this important? We need to keep all coauthors informed of the outcome of the peer review process.*)
